Bahney, formerly in the furniture business here, resides on Main street; Laura J. is the wife of Peter Gribble, formerly in the drug and livery trade of Massillon; Henrietta M. is the wife of James H. Drake, prominently engaged in mining and mercantile interests in Yuba county, Cal.; Francis S. the wife of Herbert H. Hull, of Cleveland; Josephine S. wife of Daniel Bider, of Richmond, Ind.; Amelia E. Buckius teaching painting and music in California, while Mary C. and Alice L. care for the household of their father.
